Those who wish to run for a Local Delegate Position must file a Declaration of Candidacy Form (on the back) by **4:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 15, 2018**. The form may be faxed to the SEA office at (805) 526-0130, emailed or sent through district mail to SEA. Please see the Election Timeline below for important deadlines.

Election Timeline:

February 1	Announcement of vacancies and posting at school sites
February 15	Declaration of candidacy must be received <u>no later than 4 PM</u> in the SEA office
February 20	Acknowledgement of declaration of candidacy. Campaign guidelines will be provided to each candidate. Campaigning begins.
February 27	Candidate campaign statements must be received no later than 4 PM in the SEA office
March 6- 12 at noon	Voting Online: Ballots will be sent via personal email addresses (If you have not provided a personal email address to SEA, please contact SEA in order to use a paper ballot <u>by Friday, March 9th.</u>)
March 12	Election Chair Receives Voting Results from Online Voting Company
March 13	Results will be sent to Reps to be posted at school sites
March 16	A challenge must be filed within 3 calendar days after the announcement of election results (per CTA Elections Manual).
