## **Loan Forgiveness Workshops: April 1st & 2nd**

As part of its ongoing educational service to members, SEA (in conjunction with our sister CTA Chapters in Moorpark, Conejo and Las Virgenes) will be holding **TWO** NEA Student Loan Forgiveness Workshops on April 1st & 2nd beginning at 4:00 p.m. **On Monday, April 1st, the workshop will be held at Monte Vista, Room 17.** On Tuesday, April 2nd, the workshop will be held in the Library at Westlake High School, 100 N. Lakeview Canyon Road, Westlake Village. Student teachers are welcome to attend.
