Criteria for selection:

- **The applicant must be a dependent** (as defined by I.R.S. Rules) of a **SEA Member in good standing regardless of residential geographical area.** (Membership as of September of that school year.)
- The applicant may select **any major in a two or for year accredited college, public or private.**
- The applicant must have a **B or better average (3.0 GPA) and have demonstrated good citizenship** throughout high school.
- This scholarship is available to **current high school seniors.**
- Evaluation of the following items on the application will be considered:
 - **Extracurricular activities**
 - **Community activities**
 - **Work experience**
 - **Additional information**
- Applicant's **statement or essay**, written or typed to fit on one page.

Tentative Time Line:

- Applications for candidates will be available beginning **Friday, March 1, 2019.** Candidates must submit their applications to the SEA Office **no later than 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 16th, 2019.**
- April 17th- 24th: the Scholarship Committee will review applications and set up interviews with candidates.
- **Candidate Interviews will be held between Monday, April 29th and Wednesday, May 1st.**
- Scholarship Notification: SEA tries to arrange for scholarships to be announced/awarded during the student's school awards assembly.
